

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 10 WHICH AMENDS SECTION 170 OF ARTICLE 9 IN ORDINANCE NO. 6

Section One.

That Section 170 of Article 9 in Ordinance No. 6 is hereby amended to read:

Service Connections. The District will furnish and install a service of such size and at such location as the applicant requests, provided such requests are reasonable; the service will be installed for the water distribution main to the curb line or property line of the premises which may abut on the street, on other thoroughfares, or on the District right-of-way or easement. Charges for new services are payable in advance and shall be as follows:

<u>Size of Service</u>	<u>Metered Service Charge</u>
5/8 inch	\$75.00
3/4 inch	85.00
1 inch	105.00

For services larger than one (1) inch the applicant will be billed for the actual cost of installation. The applicant will be required to deposit the estimated cost in advance of installation. After installation is completed the difference in the deposit will be refunded or billed as the case shall be.

Only duly authorized employees or agents of the District will be permitted to install a service connection from the District's main to the customer's premises. The service connection, whether located on public or private property, is the property of the District, unless specifically otherwise provided, and the District reserves the right to repair, replace and maintain it, as well as to remove it upon discontinuance of service.

Section two.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section three.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
