

ORDINANCE NO. 14AN ORDINANCE ALTERING BOUNDARIES OF IDYLLWILD
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

ANNEXATION NO. 1959-2

Idyllwild

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Idyllwild County Water District, Riverside County, California, as follows:

1. That a petition, duly acknowledged, and signed by a majority in number of the holders of title, or evidence of title, to a majority in acreage of the land described therein according to the last equalized assessment roll of the County of Riverside, together with a particular description of the land proposed to be annexed, was filed with the Secretary of said District on the 31st day of July, 1959, which petition prayed that said lands be added to the District in accordance with the provisions of the County Water District Act.

2. That the Secretary of said District duly set a date for the hearing of said petition and caused to be published in the Hemet News, a newspaper printed and published in the County of Riverside, a notice stating the purpose of the petition, describing the lands to be added and notifying all persons interested of the hearing thereon to be held on Wednesday, September 2, 1959, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. at the regular meeting place of the Board of Directors of said District, Idyllwild County Water District Office, Pinecrest Avenue and Idyllwild Banning Road, Idyllwild, California, the affidavit of which publication has been presented to and is on file with this Board, and that said petition and said notice so published are in the form required by said Act.

3. That all acts and conditions and things required by law to be done precedent to the hearing of said petition by this Board have been done and have been performed in regular and in due form and in strict compliance with the provisions of the law authorizing the presentation of said petition.

4. That at the time and place fixed in said notice this Board proceeded to hear said petition, and all written objections thereto, no such objections were received, and upon the hearing of said petition, and after full investigation and examination, this Board has found and declared and does hereby find and declare, that said petition complies with the requirements of the County Water District Act, and this Board does hereby find and declare the addition to the District of the lands proposed to be added as authorized by said Act will be for the best interest of the District and of the lands to be added.

5. That the boundaries of the Idyllwild County Water District shall be, and they are hereby, altered by adding thereto the hereinafter described territory, which territory is hereby annexed to said District, and the boundaries of which territory so annexed are situate in the County of Riverside, State of California, and are more particularly described in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and by reference incorporated herein.

6. This Ordinance shall be posted in three public places within the District.

EXHIBIT "A"

PROPERTY PROPOSED TO BE ANNEXED TO
IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
ANNEXATION NO. 1959-2

All those portions of the Southwest quarter of Section 6 and the Northwest quarter of Section 7, Township 5 South, Range 3 East, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, in unincorporated territory of the County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the center of said Section 6; thence, along the east line of said Southwest quarter of Section 6, Southerly 1320 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 6; thence, along the southerly line of said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 6, Westerly 1320 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 6; thence along the easterly line of said Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 6, Southerly 1320 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of said Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 6; thence, along the southerly line of said Section 6, Easterly 1320 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 7; thence, along the east line of the Northwest quarter of Section 7, Southerly 2640 feet, more or less, to the center of said Section 7; thence along the south line of aforementioned northwest quarter of Section 7, Westerly to the Southerly right of way line of the Banning-Idyllwild Panoramic Highway as now located, said right of way line also being a portion of the boundary of the Idyllwild County Water District, thence northwesterly along said right of way line to the west line of Section 7; thence, along the west line of said Section 7, and the west line of above mentioned Section 6, Northerly 3960 feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 6; thence, Northeasterly 1877 feet, more or less, in a direct line to the northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 6; thence, along the north line of said Southwest quarter of Section 6, Easterly 1320 feet, more or less, to said point of beginning, estimated to contain an area of 262 acres, more or less.
